

# Women In the 1920's

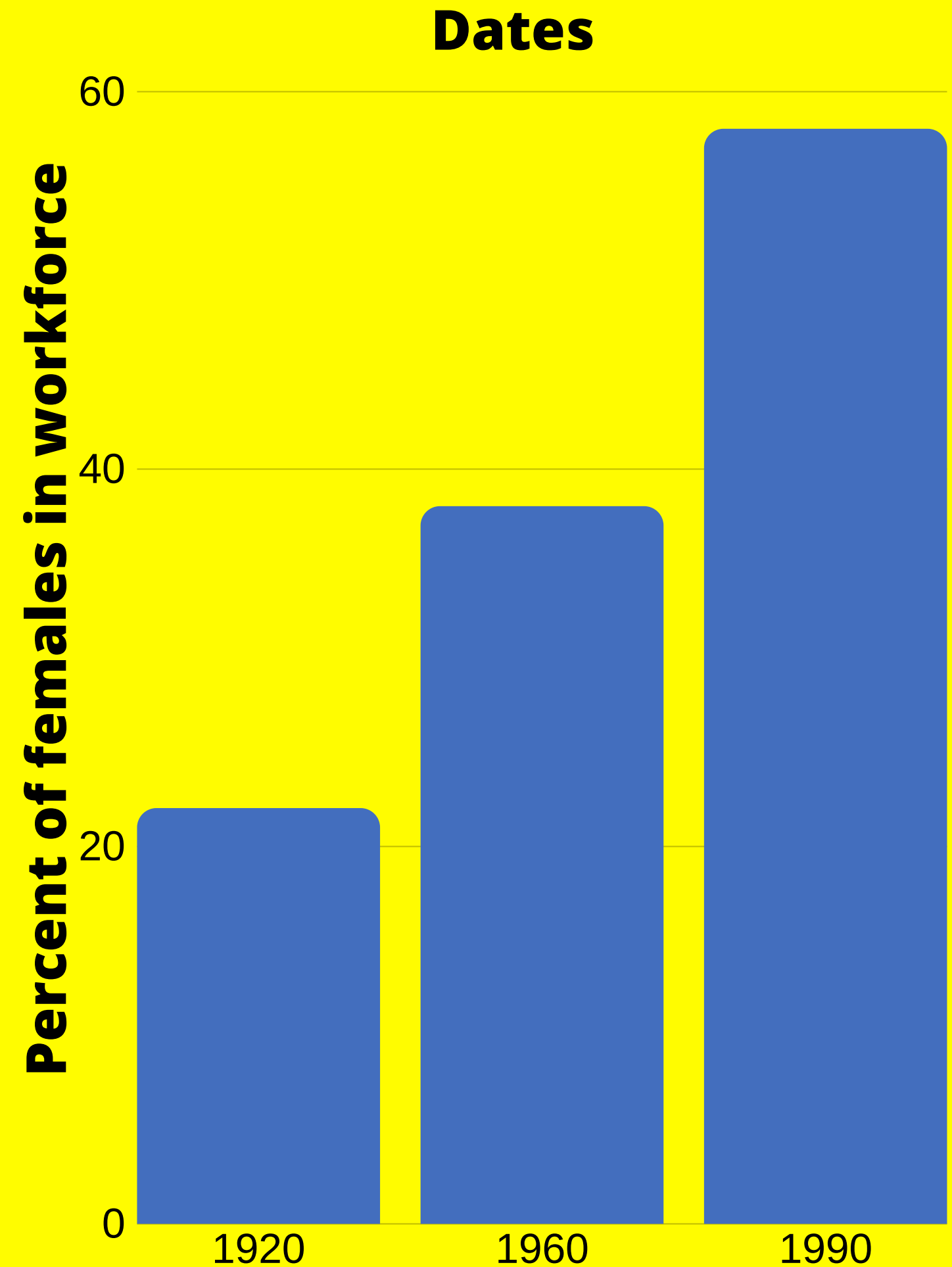


## Women in the 1920's
